The success of the women we journey with is rooted in the long-term, trusting relationships foundational to everything we do. Therefore, we are looking for a woman who loves people, is a good listener, highly relational with strong interpersonal skills, comfortable discipling others, and can quickly connect with people from diverse backgrounds—religious, socioeconomic, cultural, ethnic, educational, and social. She must possess the ability and discernment, to perceive real needs as well as to provide support and resources.

She is a creative problem solver, energetic and self-driven, yet works well with the team. She gives strong attention to detail and functions with a high degree of organization. Must be equally comfortable in a collaborative team environment and as an independent self-motivator.
